OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), and the **Endorsement** pursuant to section 40, <u>PADDA ENTERPRISES</u> <u>LIMITED</u> (the licensee) is authorised to sell by remote sale alcohol from (but not on), the premises situated at 50, Austin Street, Onekawa, Napier and known as "Big Barrel Online", to any person for consumption off the premises and to deliver it or have it delivered by some other person somewhere else.

Pursuant to s215 of the Act the authority conferred by this licence **need not** be exercised through a manager appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act at all times.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

(a) Alcohol may be sold:

At any time on any day

(b) No alcohol is to be delivered on:

Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day, nor: At any time after 11.00pm on any day and before 6.00am on the next day.

- (c) Pursuant to Regulations 14 and 15 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013:
 - (i) The licensee must take reasonable steps to verify that the buyer of any alcohol that the holder sells by remote sale (and, if a person other than the buyer is to receive it, to verify that the receiver) is not under the purchase age.
 - (ii) The licensee when selling alcohol be remote sale via the Internet must comply with any regulations made under the Act requiring information to be visible on the holder's website when people browse, enter, or otherwise access it.
 - (iii) The licensee when selling alcohol by remote sale by mail order must comply with any regulations made under the Act requiring information to be published in the holder's catalogues.
 - (iv) The licensee when selling alcohol by remote sale by telephone must comply with any regulations made under the Act requiring information to be given to callers.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) Either-
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.
